Detailed Analysis Report of Project KA-LAWEI (2022-24)

Introduction

Project KA-LAWEI was initiated to enhance the classroom teaching, and academic performance of schools by implementing digital classes. Phase 1 was implemented after the academic results of 10th grade in the year 2022, and Phase 2 followed in the academic year 2023-24. The project aims to improve student outcomes through the usage of digital classes by teachers in their classroom teaching. This report analyzes the impact of the project based on three different parameters and presents the data insights.

1. Comparison of 10TH Grade Academic Results Before and After Phase 1 Implementation

Criteria for Analysis:

• Schools with digital class usage more than 20 minutes per day (total > 27 hours in 2022-23) based on the 80 active usage days.

Top Performing Schools:

- Divine Word Secondary School: Significant improvement in both pass percentage (29.41%) and average score (9.28%).
- Sein Raij Secondary School: Notable progress with a 26.10% increase in pass percentage and a 10.50% rise in average scores.

2. Comparative Analysis of 10th Grade Academic Results, Year 2022-23 vs 2023-24 for Phase I Schools

Criteria for Analysis:

• Schools with digital class usage more than 20 minutes per day (total > 46 hours in 2023-24) based on the 139 active usage days.

Top Performing Schools:

- San Shnong Sec School: 21.01% increase in pass percentage.
- Wapung Hr. Sec School: Most significant increase in pass percentage (70.97%) and average score (18.03%).
- leng Swer Secondary School: Notable progress with a 37.95% increase in pass percentage and an 11% rise in average scores.
- Sein Jait Higher Secondary School: 23.24% increase in pass percentage and 10.57% rise in average scores.
- Umkiang Sec School: 2.39% increase in pass percentage and 7.25% rise in average scores.
- Sham Sham Secondary School: 21.32% increase in pass percentage and 11.93% rise in average scores.
- Sacred Heart Secondary School: 3.75% increase in pass percentage and 11.30% rise in average scores.
- St. Peter Secondary School: 42.20% increase in pass percentage.

3. Comparative Analysis of 10th Grade Academic Results for Phase 2 Schools (2022-23 vs 2023-24)

Criteria for Analysis:

• Schools with digital class usage more than 20 minutes per day (total > 46 hours in 2023-24) based on the 139 active usage days.

Top Performing Schools:

- Lumjingshai Sec School: Most significant improvement with a 66.67% increase in pass percentage and a 23.50% rise in average scores.
- Holy Trinity Sec School: Substantial improvement in average scores (17.66%).
- Khliehriat Hr. Sec. School: Notable improvements in both pass percentage (21.81%) and average scores (11.47%).

Positive Insights from the Overall Analysis (2022 - 2024)

- Divine Word Secondary School and Sein Raij Secondary School showed significant improvements in both pass percentage and average scores after Phase 1 implementation.
- San Shnong Sec School and Wapung Hr. Sec School exhibited notable progress in pass percentages for the academic year 2023-24 compared to 2022-23.
- Lumjingshai Sec School demonstrated the most substantial improvements among Phase 2 schools.

Conclusion

Project KA-LAWEI has positively impacted the 10th-grade academic performance of the schools with the effective usage of digital classes. Schools that met the usage criteria of more than 20 minutes per day saw significant improvements in both pass percentages and average scores. The project's integration of digital classes is proving to be beneficial, and further consistent usage could yield even better results.

Next Steps:

- 1. Increase Digital Class Usage: We will encourage schools to meet or exceed the usage criteria of 20 minutes per day to maximize benefits. Also to motivate the schools we will be starting a reward program for the best-performing schools and teachers. Special day-based activities every quarter might help encourage teachers to adopt digital classes as a supplement to their classroom teaching.
- 2. Continuous Monitoring: We will regularly monitor the performance based on the assessment results, Academic results, and digital class usage to ensure consistent improvement.

By adhering to these steps, Project KA-LAWEI can further enhance the educational outcomes across all the schools, leading to better student academic achievements in the next academic year.
